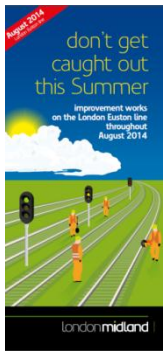

The second phase of the Watford Area Renewals Programme is fast approaching, when the line into and out of [London Euston](#) will be closed for three weekends in August. The [Abbey Line](#) will be closed from Saturday 9 August until Tuesday 26 August.
